Official Sweepstakes Rules

Residents of the continental United States who are at least 21 years of age and complete the survey entry form are eligible to participate in the Sweepstakes ("Sweepstakes") for a chance to win the Prize: two (2) tickets to "Weird Al" Yankovic: *Bigger & Weirder* Tour at the Fox Performing Arts Center and two (2) tickets to The Cheech Marin Center for Chicano Art & Culture. Only one entry per person is permitted, and no purchase is necessary to enter or win.

By participating, you agree to be unconditionally bound by these Official Sweepstakes Rules ("Rules") and confirm that you meet the eligibility requirements. You also agree to accept the decisions of the City of Riverside – Department of Marketing & Communications (Visit Riverside) as final and binding with regard to this Sweepstakes.

Compliance with these Rules will be determined solely by the Sweepstakes sponsor(s).

1. Entry Limit

Only one survey/entry is permitted per person. Multiple entries will invalidate all entries by that person. The winner must claim the prize on or before June 13, 2025, or the Prize will be forfeited. The Prize is non-transferable and has no cash value.

2. Entry Period
